What is Rubric?

Rubric is a tool that helps you state your expectations, define what will be evaluated and explain the criteria for how the evaluation of a study will be done. It helps students know what to work on.


You can upload the prepared tool onto the online platform to ensure your students are fully informed. It can also be used for peer evaluation, self-evaluation and trainer evaluation.

Therefore, you will be able to track how much change the students have made according to the feedback they have received.

Enter performances for your rubric. There are many existing performances for you to use. 


