


HOW TO INSTALL SAFE EXAM BROWSER (SEB) for Windows


SEB is a browser that disables the option of opening a new tab/window, windows task bar and many other applications during an on-going exam by locking down the screen/computer. The students at NEU are required to download SEB and install it on their computer in order to be able to sit for any kind of exam (MT, Final, exemption,...etc) administered by the university. The computers/smart devices without Safe Exam Browser will not be given access for the exams. Please follow the instructions below to install SEB onto your computer:

1. Type in 'Safe Exam Browser' into the search bar and go to safexambrowser.org.


2. Click on **Download**. Download the 3.0 version for all Windows operating systems.

New in SEB 2.4.1:

- Fixed issue when the old browser window stayed open while reconfiguring with seb(s) link, together with the Firefox file open dialog. Should fix issues when using SEB-Moodle Deeper Integration.
- Implemented fix for VMware Windows Registry error: The Registry value for "Enable VMware Client Shade" will now only be set if the active configuration explicitly says so (see new setting in SEB Config Tool / Registry / "Set VMware configuration". Don't enable this setting if you are not running SEB in a VMware Horizon View virtual desktop.
- Added Zoom to list of prohibited applications. If you want to use Zoom together with SEB, you have to set its "Active" property to false (Applications / Prohibited Processes).
- Added expansion of environment variables in path of permitted processes. This allows to configure applications to run as permitted process, which need to be installed in subdirectories of the user directory, for example %AppData%.

3. The page below will appear once you click on download. To start downloading, click on 'Save'.


5. Click on **'yes'** in the window that pops up.
6. Once the installation is complete, click on **'close'**.




7. Go to the your computer's menu and open **SEB Configuration Tool**.




8. You need to change the address stated in the **'Start URL'** section by writing <https://uzem.neu.edu.tr/>




9. To save the changes, click on **'File'** and then **'save settings'**.




10. Once you complete all these, you can enter the exam by clicking on the **Safe Exam Browser icon on the desktop.**



11. If a warning like the one below pops up, that means that you have open applications. Click on **'yes'** to continue. Otherwise, you can not access the UZEBİM platform.




12. **Log in** (at the top-right corner) to the NEU UZEBİM platform by entering your username and password.
